at the hands of the Prime Minister in the year 2007 for the empowerment of Physically Challenged Persons.

Future Plan: Our vision is to achieve the goal of totally disabled free society where they are able to fully participate in social and national life of the country. Towards this end, in addition to maximizing our efforts to provide artificial limbs and aids to physically challenged brethren, our greater emphasis in future will be in their rehabilitation by making them economically self sufficient and socially acceptable.



VIKLANG SAHAYATA

Bharat Vikas Parishad is a non-political voluntary organization. It is dedicated to the development and growth of our country in all fields of human endeavour - cultural, social, academic, moral, national and spiritual - by promoting a sense of patriotism, national unity and integrity.

The main aim of the Parishad is to organise the elite, intellectuals and the well-to-do citizens and to motivate them to serve our poor, disabled, illiterate and ignorant brethren not as an act of charity but in the true spirit of our cultural tradition of service as duty.

With its first branch established in 1963 in New Delhi, it has now 1250 branches and a membership of 55000 families all over India with a number of branches outside India as well. Bharat Vikas Parishad is running over 1460 permanent projects, whose activities are conducted on daily or weekly basis. These projects include Viklang Sahayata Kendras, Hospitals, Clinics, Physiotherapy Centers, Mobile Vans, Pathology Labs Ultrasound Centers, Blood Banks, Educational Institutions, etc.

Need for the Viklang Sahayata:

According to Census of India 2011, the **disabled in India numbered 2.68 crore** which constitute more than 2 percent of total population.

Of the total disabled persons in the country, **54 lakh people have movement disability -** persons who lack limbs or are unable to use the limbs normally. Further, it is estimated that about 40,000 persons become disabled every year due to various reasons.

In view of the enormity of the problem, Bharat Vikas Parishad decided in 1990 to take up Viklang Sahayata and Punarvas Yojana as one of its national programs. There are now 13 centers, which provide artificial limbs and other aids to the disabled persons.

Manufacturing of Artificial Limbs: Our centers are equipped with the most modern equipment to manufacture artificial limbs and other attachments. The trained technicians at these establishments, through R&D, have developed improved limbs which are not only very light but also highly efficient. The limbs manufactured by the centers are rapid fit, cosmetically and functionally close to human

limbs that permit normal sitting, squatting, walking, running, climbing, swimming, driving etc. The disabled persons, after the fitment, can even lift heavy weights and work in workshops and farms.

Rehabilitation - A Prime Necessity: Another important aspect of the problem of the disabled is their economic and social rehabilitation. Merely providing artificial limbs to the disabled persons is not enough. Accordingly, the Parishad has adopted a scheme of self-employment for disabled persons. The idea is to inculcate a sense of self-respect in the affected persons and also to enable them to earn their living in an honorable way.

There are a number of centers in various parts of the country which are working actively for the rehabilitation of the handicapped persons so as to enable them to live an independent life. These centers impart training in various vocations like computers, repair of televisions, tailoring, printing of fabrics, bookbinding, making of candles, chalks, dusters, carpentry and such other jobs. Besides that efforts are made to secure employment for them in factories, offices, and other establishments. The centers also arrange marriages of the handi-

capped persons.

Bharat Vikas Parishad is the only non-governmental organization that renders service to the largest number of handicapped persons in the country year after year. Since the establishment of its first Viklang Kendra at Delhi in 1990, Bharat Vikas Parishad has been serving the physically challenged brethren by providing artificial limbs as well as by assisting in their rehabilitation. Bharat Vikas Parishad provides about 20,000 artificial limbs and other aids through its Viklang Kendras and branches every year.

It is matter of pride that two of our Viklang centers have won President's award for service to the handicapped persons. In 1995, President of India presented the National Award for the welfare of the handicapped to Delhi Bharat Vikas Foundation in public recognition of its outstanding performance for the welfare of handicapped persons.

Similarly in December, 2004 President of India bestowed National Award to Parishad's Viklang Sahayata Kendra at Ludhiana for the welfare of persons with disabilities.

Ludhiana Kendra has also the distinction of receiving FICCI award
