Guidelines for Prant Elections

- 1. Observer for prant election will be appointed by regional National Vice President / Addl. Secretary General in consultation with the Central Office.
- 2. The election of Prant PST will be conducted by the Electoral College.
- 3. Regional observer with the help of Prant Organizing Secretary will conduct the election.
- 4. Electoral college for the election will be
 - i) AOP (Branch) PST who have submitted their central and state shares upto 31st December 2018.
 - ii) All the Individual members residing in the prant jurisdiction.
- 5. Newly elected Office Bearers will send the election reporting proforma (with photographs) to the Central Office.
- 6. All the newly elected Office Bearers will nominate the Prant executive. The Executive Committee of total eight persons i.e. (1) Organizing Secretary (one) in consultation with National Organizing Secretary (2) Mahila Pramukh (one), (3) Vice President Sewa, (4) Vice President Sanskar, (5) Vice President Sampark. One Vice President in case of less than 25 branches, Two Vice President in case of 25-50 branches and Three Vice President in case of above 50 branches.

As per the number of Vice President, remaining will be Executive Members. Newly elected Office Bearers will propose one / two name for Prant Patron to the Regional Office.

- No elected or nominated member of Prant executive should be above 75 years of age
- No member can be nominated who have completed 4 years or (two terms) for his designation.
- For giving inspiration for woman leadership it is advised to nominate one more mahila members in the Prant executive (other than mahila convener)
- Prant account will be transferred in the name of newly elected PSTs only after receiving the election reports.
- Normally no new accounts will be allowed to open. The old account should be maintained.
